

## CHAPTER LXXXIX.

*An Act to organize the County of Cottonwood.*March 3, 1870.

- SECTION 1. Commissioners to be appointed to locate county seat of said county—by whom appointed—how county seat may be changed.
2. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That the governor take such action (under existing laws) as may be necessary to organize the county of Cottonwood, and appoint three disinterested persons, commissioners to locate the county seat of said county, the place designated by said commissioners, or a majority of them, when reported to the governor, shall remain the seat of justice of said county until confirmed or changed, by a vote of the legal voters of said county, when submitted to them in accordance with the provisions of the constitution of the state of Minnesota.
