

CHAPTER XCVI.

Feb'y 18, 1870.*An Act to organize the County of Carlton.*

SECTION 1. Organisation of said county—when election to be held for county officers.

2. Where county seat located.

3. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*Organization of
Carlton county—
when county offi-
cers to be elected.

SECTION 1. That the county of Carlton, in this state, shall be hereafter entitled to all the powers of an organized county. That the qualified electors of said county shall meet in the election districts prescribed by this act, on the first Tuesday in May next, and elect three county commissioners, one sheriff, one county treasurer, one county auditor, one register of deeds, and one coroner, for said county, to hold their offices until the next general election, and until their successors are elected and qualified.

Where county
seat located.

SEC. 2. That the county seat of said county is hereby established at Thompson City, near the dalles of the St. Louis river, and that until otherwise provided, that townships forty-eight and forty-nine, in ranges sixteen and seventeen, shall form one election district, the election therein to be held at Thompson City; and that the residue of said county shall form another election district, the election therein to be held at Moose Head Lake.

SEC. 3. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
