

CHAPTER CXXII.

March 1, 1870.

An Act authorizing the Great Western Mining Company of the State of Pennsylvania, to transact business in this State.

SECTION 1. Said Company authorized to purchase and hold real estate necessary to carry on the business of mining in this State.

2. To appoint a resident agent in this State—for what purpose.

3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

May purchase
and hold real estate
in this state.

SECTION 1. That the Great Western Mining Company organized under an act of the legislature of the state of Pennsylvania, approved April second, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, (a copy of which act of incorporation is filed in the office of the secretary of state of this state) be and said corporation is, in its said corporate name of the Great Western Mining Company, authorized to acquire and hold, purchase or lease such property, real and personal, as may be necessary and convenient to carry on the business of mining, manufacturing, working in, and selling and disposing of, iron and slate within this state, to contract and be contracted with, sue and be sued, and exercise such powers as are necessary for the purpose of carrying on its said business,

To appoint a
resident agent—
for what purpose.

SEC. 2. That said corporation shall constitute and appoint an agent, who shall reside at Thompson City, in the county of Carlton in this state, duly authorized to accept service of process, and upon whom service of process may be made, in any action in which said corporation may be a party, and continually have and keep some resident agent at said Thompson City, so as aforesaid empowered, and service upon such agent, shall be taken and held as due service upon said corporation.

When act to take
effect.

SEC. 3. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
