

## CHAPTER CLV.

March 5, 1870. *An Act to provide for the location of a State Road from Burnsville, in Dakota County, to Shakopee, in Scott County.*

- SECTION 1. Commissioners appointed to locate, survey and establish said road.
2. When and where to meet—vacancy, how filled.
  3. May employ surveyor and assistants—to file survey of plat.
  4. How expenses of locating said road to be defrayed.
  5. When road to be deemed established and opened.
  6. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

Commissioners appointed to locate a state road.

SECTION 1. That Martin Quinn, of Hamilton, J. W. Humphrey, of Eagle Creek Mills, and Peter Yost, of Shakopee city, Scott county, are hereby appointed commissioners to survey, locate and establish a state road from some point to be by them selected in the township of Burnsville, in Dakota county, running thence by way of Hamilton and Eagle Creek Mills, in Scott county, to said Shakopee city.

When and where to meet—vacancy, how filled.

SEC. 2. That said commissioners shall meet at such time and place as shall be convenient to them, and proceed to discharge the duties imposed upon them by this act; *Provided*, That if either of said commissioners shall be unable to discharge said duties, the others shall have the power to substitute some person to act in his place, and such action by such substitute shall have the same effect as if he were appointed commissioner by this act.

May employ a surveyor, &c.—to file plat.

SEC. 3. That said commissioners are hereby authorized to employ a surveyor, axman and chainman, and it shall be their duty to cause said road to be accurately surveyed and platted, and file a copy thereof in the office of county auditor in each [county] through or into which said road may pass, to assess the damages and to secure a release of the right of way to said road.

SEC. 4. That the several towns through which said road may pass, proportionately, shall pay all the expenses of the location and survey of said road; *Provided*, That the commissioners shall not receive more than two dollars and fifty cents per day, and not to exceed three days each, and the axmen and chainmen, one dollar and fifty cents per day each; *Provided further*, That all expenses for the right of way for said road shall be paid for by the several towns through which the said road passes, the same as township roads.

How expense of locating road to be defrayed.

SEC. 5. That said road shall be deemed established and opened upon filing the survey and plat thereof, which plat shall be legal evidence of the location and existence of said road.

When road deemed to be opened.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.
