CHAPTER XXV.

An Act to amend Chapter Eight, of an act entitled "an act to incorporate the City of Minneapolis," approved February Sixth, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Chapter Eight (8), Special Laws of 1867, by the addition of the following Section:

- Common Council authorized to levy a tax for street improvements how levied and collected.
- 2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That chapter eight, of an act entitled "an act to incorporate the city of Minneapolis," approved February sixth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, be amended by adding thereto the following section:

Council authorized to levy a tax for street improvements—how collected.

Sec. 6. The common council may levy assessments for planting shade trees and protecting the same; Provided, That trees that shall have been already set out shall not be required to be removed except at the expense and risk of the city. And for the building of sidewalks, and other local improvements in said city, upon the property fronting upon such improvements, or upon the property to be benefited by such improvements, without regard to the cash valuation of such property, and such assessments shall be levied, assessed and collected in the manner prescribed by sections two, three and four of this chapter.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
