## CHAPTER XXXVII.

An Act to authorize the Board of Supervisors of the Township of West Saint Paul, in Dakota County, to March 2, 1870. levy a tax of Two Thousand Dollars on the real and personal property in Road District Number Five, in said Town, to build a road in said district.

- SECTION 1. Board of Supervisors authorized to levy a tax-for what purpose.
  - Board to have general supervision of the location and construction of said road.
  - 3. Authorized to levy the whole amount of tax in one assessment—duty of County Auditor.

When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the board of supervisors of the township of West St. Paul, in Dakota county, is hereby fully authorized and empowered to levy a tax, not to ex- To levy a taxceed two thousand dollars, on the real and personal property, not exempted from taxation by the laws of this state, of road district number five in said township, the same to be levied, worked, collected and certified as provided by law for other road tax, for the purpose and no other, of building a suitable road for general travel in a portion of said district, said road to be constructed above high water mark.

SEC. 2. The said board of supervisors shall locate, record and construct said road in compliance with the Who to have the statute in such cases made and provided, and shall desig-struction and location of road. nate some suitable person to superintend the said work, or let the same by contract to the lowest bidder, as they may deem best.

SEC. 3. The said board of supervisors may levy the May intry whole whole amount of said tax in one assessment, or more than manufacture of the man one, as they may deem best, and it is hereby made the auditor. duty of the county auditor of said county to extend such amounts as the said board may certify, not to exceed the

amount specified in section one of this act, on the assessment roll of the taxable property of said district, and such tax so levied, shall be collected by the county treasurer, or returned by him as delinquent, in such manner as is prescribed by the laws of the state in relation to taxes levied in towns.

When act to take effect. SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER XXXVIII.

March 1, 1870.

An Act to legalize and confirm the actions of the Board of Supervisors of the Town of West Saint Paul, in locating, laying out and surveying a certain road in said Town.

- SECTION 1. The action of the Board of Supervisors in altering and surveying a certain roadis hereby confirmed and made walld.
  - Legalisation of that portion of said road so changed and located—what to be deemed evidence of the location of said road.
  - 8. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Action of board of supervisors made valid. Section 1. That the acts, proceedings and resolutions of the board of supervisors of the township of West St. Paul, in the county of Dakota, in said state, in locating, laying out and causing to be surveyed, the alteration and change of a certain road in said township, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the north side of the south-east quarter of section twenty, in township twenty-eight north, of range twenty-two west, thence running along said line till it intersects the said road in response to the petition of Jacob Martharler, Wm. K. Dixon, and others, be and the same are hereby confirmed, made valid, and declared to be legal in all respects.
