

CHAPTER CIV.

March 8, 1871.

An Act to appropriate money for deficiencies and the further completion of the Minnesota Hospital for the Insane.

- SECTION 1. Appropriation for deficiencies and further completion of the Hospital for Insane.
1. For deficiencies.
 2. For further completion of Hospital building—how appropriation may be drawn.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation for deficiencies, etc.

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated, out of any money in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund not otherwise appropriated:

First.—The sum of twenty-six thousand one hundred and sixty-nine dollars for the deficiency in building, heating, drainage, and finishing for occupation the Minnesota hospital for insane, for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine.

How appropriation may be drawn.

Second.—The sum of forty thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary to be expended in the further completion of the Minnesota hospital for insane; the same to be paid on warrants drawn by the president, and countersigned by the secretary of board of trustees of that institution, and that on the presentation of such warrants on the state auditor it shall be his duty to draw warrants on the state treasurer for like amount; such money to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of the Minnesota hospital for the insane.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
