

CHAPTER CV.

An Act to appropriate money for the support of Indigent Insane.

March 3, 1871.

SECTION 1. Appropriation for the current expenses of the Hospital for Insane—how appropriation may be drawn.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of fifty-six thousand dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated for the current expenses of the Minnesota hospital for insane, the same to be paid on warrants drawn by the president and countersigned by the secretary of the board of trustees of that institution, for the estimated expenses thereof, monthly in advance, and that on the presentation of such warrants on the state auditor, it shall be his duty to draw warrants on the state treasurer for like amount, such money to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of the Minnesota hospital for the insane.

Appropriation for the current expenses of Hospital for Insane—how appropriation may be drawn.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
