

CHAPTER CVIII.

March 3, 1871.

An Act to appropriate money to pay indebtedness of First State Normal School.

SECTION 1. Appropriation to pay indebtedness of First State Normal School—how appropriation may be drawn.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

To pay indebtedness of First State Normal School—how appropriation may be drawn.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of ten thousand seven hundred and fifty-four dollars and eighty-four cents, to be expended in paying balance due on account of building, furnishing and running expenses of the first state normal school at Winona, the same to be paid on warrants drawn by the president of the normal school board, and countersigned by the secretary thereof. Upon the presentation of such warrants to the state auditor, he shall forthwith draw warrants on the state treasurer for the amount named in the warrants of the said president and secretary, not exceeding in all the said sum of ten thousand seven hundred and fifty-four dollars and eighty-four cents, and the money drawn upon said warrants shall be expended under the direction of the state normal board in paying the indebtedness as aforesaid.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
