

CHAPTER CXIII.

An Act to appropriate money for certain purposes therein named.

March 3, 1871.

SECTION 1. Appropriation to meet expense incurred in contested election case—in what amount.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation to pay expenses of contested election case.

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse A. L. Patchin, for expenses incurred by him in contesting the seat of G. C. Chamberlin, in the house of representatives, the sum of one hundred and seventy dollars (\$170).

When act to take effect

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
