

CHAPTER LXXX.

An Act to detach the County of Watonwan from the County of Blue Earth, and for attaching thereto the Counties of Cottonwood, Murray and Pipestone for judicial purposes, and to establish a term of the District Court in Watonwan County.

March 6, 1871.

- SECTION 1.** Detached from Blue Earth County.
2. Time of holding terms of District Court in Watonwan County.
 3. Actions arising in undetached territory, where triable.
 4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the county of Watonwan be detached from the county of Blue Earth for judicial purposes, and that the counties of Cottonwood, Murray and Pipestone be attached to the last named counties for the same purposes.

Detached from Blue Earth County.

SEC. 2. A term of the district court shall be held at Madelia, in Watonwan county, commencing on the second Tuesday of February in each year, and all actions and judicial proceedings, civil and criminal, arising in the counties of Cottonwood, Murray, Pipestone, or Watonwan, and pending in court when this act takes effect, shall be returnable to and be made to pend and be tried in the last named county. And the clerk of the district court for the county of Blue Earth shall transmit all papers relating thereto and remaining in his office to the clerk of the district court of Watonwan county immediately after this act taking effect.

Time of holding terms of District Court.

SEC. 3. All actions or crimes heretofore or hereafter arising or committed in the counties of Cottonwood, Murray or Pipestone, shall be triable in said county of Blue Earth until said county of Watonwan shall be detached therefrom, and thereafter in the county of Watonwan.

Actions where triable in undetached territory.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect on the fifteenth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one,

except section three thereof, which shall take effect immediately on its passage.

CHAPTER LXXXI.

An Act to change the time of holding the District Court in the counties of Jackson and Martin.

March 1, 1871.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Section two (2), Chapter eighty-six (86), General Laws of 1870
 Time of holding terms of District Court in Jackson and Martin counties.
 2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section two of chapter eighty-six of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows :

Time of holding terms of District Court.

Sec. 2. There shall be held in the said counties of Jackson and Martin, a regular term of the district court as follows : In the county of Jackson on the fourth Tuesday in June of each year, and in the county of Martin on the fourth Tuesday in January of each year.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
