## CHAPTER LXXXVII.

March 6, 1871. An Act to detach the county of Becker from the county of Douglas, and to establish general terms of court in suid county.

SECTION 1. Detached from the county of Douglas for judicial purposes.

- 2. Time of holding terms of court in Becker county.
- 8. All writs, recognizances, etc., deemed to be returned to such court.
- 4. Repeal of inconsistent acts.
- 5. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Detached for judicial purposes. Section 1. That the county of Becker be and the same is hereby detached from the county of Douglas for judicial and all other purposes.

Time of holdidg terms of District Court.

SEC. 2. General terms of the district court shall be held in and for said county of Becker, in the seventh judicial district, annually on the first Tuesday of September.

Where writs, etc., deemed returnable. SEC. 3. All judicial proceedings now pending in, all recognizances and writs returnable to the district court in the county of Douglas, from said county of Becker, shall be made pending in and returnable to the district court in Becker county, and to the term of such court as fixed by this act.

Repeal of inconsistent acts. SEC. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

When act to take effect, SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
