GENERAL LAWS

CHAPTER XCII.

March 6, 1871. An Act to amend Section two hundred and twenty-four, of Title twelve, of Chapter eight, of the General Statutes relating to County Coroners.

> SECTION 1. Amendment to Section 'two hundred and twenty-four (224), This twelve (12), Chapter eight (8), General Statutes, Yacancy in office, how filled.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two hundred and twenty-four of title twelve, of chapter eight, of the general statutes, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 224. Each deputy shall act in his own name as Vacancy in office, deputy coroner, and hold his office during the pleasure of the coroner, and whenever a vacancy occurs in the office of coroner, the board of county commissioners, at their first seesion thereafter, shall appoint some suitable person to fill such vacancy until the next general election and until a successor is elected and qualified.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from effect.
