CHAPTER CXI.

March 4, 1871.

An Act to organize a School District in the county of Dakota.

SECTION 1. Organization of school district—boundary lines.

1. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

School district organized—
boundary lines.

SECTION 1. All that part of town one hundred and fifteen north, of range nineteen west, described as follows: Sections thirty and thirty-one, the southwest quarter of section twenty-nine, and all of section thirty-two except the north half of the northeast quarter thereof, is hereby declared to be a school district; and the inhabitants of said district are hereby authorized and empowered to meet and organize under the general laws of this state relating to the organization of school districts.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
