CHAPTER CXXXV.

March 6, 1871. An Act for the relief of James Hunter, Sheriff of Rice County.

Shorton 1. Commissioners authorised to audit and cause to be paid certain account.

2. When act to take effect,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the county commissioners of the county of Rice are hereby authorized and empowered to to be paid certain audit and cause to be paid from the county treasury of said county the account of James Hunter, sheriff of said county, for his expenses in detending an action of false imprisonment brought against him by one Patrick Condon, if, in their judgment, said account is just and reasonable and was necessarily incurred by said Hunter in the discharge of his duty as a peace officer.

When not to take SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
