

CHAPTER XV.

An Act to amend Subdivision sixteen of Section one of an act entitled an act to reduce the special laws relating to the Town of Faribault, in the County of Rice, and State of Minnesota, heretofore passed, into one act, and to amend the same.

March 1, 1871.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Subdivision one (1), Section one (1), Chapter thirty-seven (37), Special Laws of 1868. To license auctioneers—restrictions—penalty for violation.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

To license auctioneers—restrictions—penalty for violation.

SECTION 1. That subdivision sixteen of an act entitled an act to reduce the special laws relating to the town of Faribault, in the county of Rice and state of Minnesota, heretofore passed, into one act, and to amend the same, approved March sixth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, be amended by adding thereto the following proviso, to wit: *Provided*, That no goods, wares or merchandise shall be sold by any auctioneer so licensed, unless the same is the property of a citizen of said county of Rice; and no auctioneer so licensed shall directly or indirectly depute any other person to act as auctioneer under said license, or allow any other person to act under or avail himself of any right arising therefrom; and any person selling any goods or property within said town without first procuring a license as aforesaid, or who shall violate any of the provisions of this subdivision of said section, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and punished by a fine of one hundred dollars for each and every such offense.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
