

## CHAPTER XXVII.

March 1, 1871.

*An Act to amend an act entitled "An act to incorporate the Village of Caledonia," approved February twenty-fourth, one thousand eight hundred and seventy.*

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Section three (3), Chapter eight (8), Special Laws of 1870. Management of said corporation vested in a Board of Trustees—elective officers—what officers to be appointed—term of office—vacancy, how filled.
2. Amendment to Section four (4) of said act. Elective offices.
3. Amendment to Section section seven (7) of said act. Power to appoint officers.
4. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That section three of an act entitled an act to incorporate the village of Caledonia, approved February twenty-fourth, one thousand eight hundred and seventy, be amended so as to read as follows :

In whom management of said corporation vested—elective officers—what officers appointed—term of office—vacancy, how filled.

Sec. 3. The government of said corporation and the management of all its municipal concerns shall be vested in three trustees, one of whom shall be selected by themselves as president, one treasurer, one justice of the peace, one assessor, one constable, one clerk, who shall be residents of said village. The trustees, treasurer, justice of the peace, assessor, constable and clerk shall be elected by the qualified voters of said village. The trustees, treasurer, assessor, constable and clerk shall hold their office for one year, and the justice of the peace for two years, and until their successors are elected and qualified. The trustees may fill by appointment any vacancy in any of the village offices, except vacancy in the office of justice of the peace.

Elective officers.

SEC. 2. That section four of said act, approved February twenty-fourth, one thousand eight hundred and seventy, be amended by inserting in the fifth line after the word peace, and before the word of, the words "assessor, constable and clerk."

SEC. 3. That the clause commencing in the second

line of section seven of said act, and reading as follows: Power to appoint officers.  
 "They shall appoint a clerk, assessor and constable, and such other officers as may be deemed necessary, and to prescribe by by-laws the duties of such officers when not defined by law," shall be changed so as to read as follows, to wit: They shall appoint such other officers not herein named as may be deemed necessary, and to prescribe by by-laws the duties of such officers when not defined by law.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from When act to take effect.  
 and after its passage.

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## CHAPTER XXVIII.

*An Act to amend an act, entitled an act to Incorporate the City of Minneapolis, approved February sixth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven.* March 1, 1871.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Section two (2), Chapter six (6) of the act incorporating the City of Minneapolis, Special Laws of 1867. Council authorized to take private property for public use.
2. Amendment to Section three (3), of said act. Repeal of certain clause—damages for appropriating private property, how ascertained.
3. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That section two of chapter six, of an act entitled an act to incorporate the city of Minneapolis, approved February sixth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, be amended by adding thereto the following, to-wit: "And said common council shall have power, whenever it shall be necessary for such purposes, to condemn, take and use private property, for the laying Authorized to take private property for public use.
