

CHAPTER LXXIV.

March 6, 1871.

An Act to provide for the payment of expenses, incurred in prosecuting County Officers in Mower County.

SECTION 1. Commissioners authorized to issue County orders—for what purpose—in what amount.

2. Orders, how paid.

3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Authorized to issue orders—in what amount—for what purpose.

SECTION 1. That the board of county commissioners of Mower county, are hereby authorized to issue county orders of said county, to pay the expenses incurred in prosecuting Harvey M. Allen, late county auditor of said county, and George W. Bishop, late county commissioner of said county, and to deliver said county orders to such persons and in such amounts as they may severally be entitled to; *Provided*, That the whole amount of orders so issued, shall not exceed the sum of six hundred dollars.

Orders, how paid.

SEC. 2. That the said board of county commissioners are hereby authorized to levy a tax upon the taxable property of said county, and the county auditor is hereby required to insert the same upon the tax list of said county for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one, sufficient to redeem the orders thus issued.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force on and after its passage.
