

Repeal of former act. of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy be and the same is hereby repealed.

Location of county seat. SEC. 2. That the county seat of said county of Otter Tail be and the same is hereby re-established and confirmed at Otter Tail City.

When act to take effect. SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXXVI.

February 16, 1871 *An Act to authorize the Commissioners of the County of Scott to issue bonds to fund the debt of said county.*

SECTION 1. Authorized to issue bonds—for what purpose—at what rate of interest—when payable.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Authorized to issue bonds—for what purpose—what rate of interest—when payable. SECTION 1. That the board of county commissioners of the county of Scott are hereby authorized and empowered to issue county bonds to be known as fund bonds in exchange for and in lieu of the floating orders issued by said county, said bonds shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding ten per cent. per annum, and shall be made payable at any time not less than five years from the date thereof.

Principal and interest, how paid. SEC. 2. The said commissioners are hereby authorized and empowered to pledge the faith of the said county by said bonds for the payment thereof. Said bonds shall be signed by the chairman of said board of commissioners and countersigned by the auditor of said county, and shall be sealed with the seal of said county, and the county

auditor of said county may, when authorized by said board of commissioners, draw warrants on the county treasury for the amount of interest due on said fund bonds from the interest fund in the treasury.

SEC. 3. That all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act be and the same are hereby repealed.

Repeal of inconsistent acts.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXXVII.

An Act to authorize the Clerk of the District Court of Scott county, Eighth Judicial District, to perfect certain records in office. February 17, 1871.

SECTION 1. Clerk of Court to procure record and index books—for what purpose.

1. Declarations of intention to have same effect as the originals.
2. Fees of Clerk of Court.
3. How paid.
4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The clerk of the district court in and for the county of Scott, eighth judicial district, is hereby authorized and required to procure such books and index books at the expense of the county of Scott, as may be necessary, and record therein all declarations of intentions to become citizens of the United States, and all final papers of citizens, now on file in his office, but not of record, and index the same in alphabetical order.

To procure record and index book—for what purpose.

SEC. 2. The said declarations of intention, and the said final papers, so recorded, shall be of the same force and effect as the originals themselves.
