## CHAPTER CXVI.

An Act to Reimburse the County of Pope for the Expenses of the Trial and Conviction of Charles Bailey.

February 20 1872.

SECTION 1. Appropriation to Pope county for expenses incurred.

2. The state auditor authorized to draw a warrant for the amount.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION. 1. That the sum of five hundred and eighty-six Appropriation dollars and thirty cents, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse the county of Pope for the expense of the trial and conviction of Charles Bailey for the shooting of John M. Joy.

That the state auditor draw a warrant on the state treasurer in favor of the county of Pope for said amount and transmit the same by mail or otherwise to the treasurer of Pope county, who shall draw the money and place the same to the county revenue fund.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
