CHAPTER LXXXVIII.

An Act to detach the County of Wilkin from the County of Douglas and attach it to the County of Otter Tail for Judicial and Recording purposes.

February 29,

Section 1. Wilkin county attached to Otter Tail county for judicial purposes.

- 2. Proceedings returnable to Douglas county, to be returned to Ofter Tail
- 3. Repeal of inconsistent acts.
- 4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The county of Wilkin is hereby detached wilkin county from the county of Douglas and attached to the county of attached to

Otter Tail for judicial and recording purposes.

All judicial proceedings now pending [in] and all recognizances and writs returnable to the district court in the county of Douglas from said county of Wilkin shall be made pending in and returnable to the district court in Otter Tail county, and to the term of such court as fixed by law.

Sec. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this

act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
