CHAPTER CXXI

An Act to amend Section four of An act entitled An act to Incorporate the St. John Seminary, Approved March 6th, A. D. 1857.

SECTION 1. Amendment to section 4, relating to corporate rights.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SEC. 1. That section four of an act entitled "An Act to incorporate the St. John Seminary, approved March 6th, A. D. 1857, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

SEC. 4. This politic and corporate body shall be empowered by its representatives, with rights as such of suing and being sued, of contracting and being contracted with, of purchasing, holding and selling real and personal estate, of making and using a common seal and altering the same at pleasure; provided always, that the annual income of said

corporation shall not exceed the sum of sixty thousand dollars.

CHAPTER CXXII.

An Act to amend an act relative to the branch line of the Lake Superior and Mississippi Railroad, authorized by Section two of the amended act relating to said Railroad Company, approved March 5th, 1861, more definitely locating said Branch.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to section 2, relating to the construction of a branch from North Branch to Taylor's Falls.
2. Conditions upon which the rights and privileges of this act are granted.
 3. Repeal of inconsistent acts.
 4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That so much of section two of said act as relates to the construction of a branch road from the main line of said road, to the navigable waters of the St. Croix River, be and the same is hereby amended so that it shall read as follows:

Branch road.

That the Lake Superior and Mississippi Railroad Company is hereby authorized to survey, locate, construct and perpetually to operate the branch line of its railroad authorized by the provisions of section two (2) of the act entitled "An Act to incorporate the Nebraska and Lake Superior Railroad Company," approved March 5th, 1861, by constructing
