CHAPTER CLVII.

March 4, 1872. An Act to Locate a State Road from Chengwatana, in Pine County, to Brunswick, in Kunabec County.

Section 1. State road between Chengwatana and Brunswick legalized.

- 2. Requires the commissioners of the respective counties to improve the same.
- 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

State road legalized. SECTION 1. That the line of road as laid out and platted between Chengwatana, by way of Pine City, in Pine county, and Brunswick, in Kanabec county, be and the same is hereby established as a state road and public highway, and that upon filing the plat and the field notes of the survey of said roads, as made by J. D. Wilcox and Capt. Jas. Stewart, in the office of the register of deeds of said Pine county, and a duplicate thereof in the office of the register of deeds of Kanabec county, the location of said road shall be deemed complete.

Improvement

Sec. 2. That it shall be the duty of the county commissioners of the respective counties in and through which said road is laid out and opened, to cause those portions thereof in their respective counties to be improved and to be kept in constant repair, so that the same shall be made suitable for use as a public highway.

When act to

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and atter its passage.
