

CHAPTER XXXVIII.

An Act to Amend an act entitled "An Act to incorporate certain towns in this Territory," approved May 23d, A. D. 1857.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to section 65 of Special Laws of 1857, relating to levy of taxes in certain towns.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section sixty-five [65] of an act entitled "An Act to incorporate certain towns in this Territory," approved May twenty-third, (23d) A. D. 1857, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Relating to
taxes.

SEC. 65. For the purpose of enabling the town council of each of said towns, to carry into effect the provisions of this act, they are hereby authorized and empowered to tax by general and special assessment, all the property within their respective limits, made taxable by the laws of this Territory: Provided that said tax shall not exceed in any one year five per cent of the last assessed valuation of said property.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
