

now in process of erection, the same to be paid on warrants drawn by the president and countersigned by the secretary of the board of trustees of that institution, and that on the presentation of such warrants on the state auditor it shall be his duty to draw warrants on the state treasurer for like amounts, such money to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of the Minnesota hospital for the insane.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. Act takes effect.

CHAPTER CXXVIII.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR ERECTING AND COMPLETING BUILDINGS FOR THE MINNESOTA INSTITUTE FOR THE DEAF AND DUMB, AND THE BLIND.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of forty thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to be expended in the erection and completion of buildings for the Minnesota institute for the deaf and dumb, and the blind, the same to be paid upon warrants drawn by the president and countersigned by the secretary of the board of directors of that institution, and that on presentation of such warrants to the state auditor it shall be his duty to draw warrants on the state treasurer for like amounts, such money to be expended under the direction of the board of directors of the Minnesota institute for the deaf, dumb and blind aforesaid.

For buildings for the deaf dumb and blind—
\$40,000.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. Act takes effect.
