CHAPTER CXXXVIII.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE UNEXPENDED PORTION OF THE GETTYSBURG BATTLEFIELD MEMORIAL ASSOCIA-TION FUND, AND DISPOSING OF THE SAME.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That so much of the sum of one thousand dollars, appropriated by an act entitled "An act to ap-Antietam associa propriate money to aid in preserving the battlefield of tion-balance of Gettysburg," the same being chapter one hundred and sted to the Getone of the general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy, is fund. as now remains unexpended, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be drawn upon the order of the governor to be expended by the intictam association, but only in such way as the governor of this state shall consent to and approve.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from Act takes effect. and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXXXIX.

AN ACT FOR AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE ERECTION OF A MONUMENT TO THE MEMORY OF THE OF. FICERS AND SOLDIERS OF THE FIFTH MINNESOTA VOL-UNTEER INFANTRY, BURIED AT FORT RIDGELY, MINNE-SOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota;

Section 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in Monument at the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be expended too. in the erection of a monument to the memory of the offi-
