

CHAPTER CXLI.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PAY THE MEMBERS OF THE FIRST REGIMENT MINNESOTA NATIONAL GUARD FOR SERVICES IN THE BLUEBERRY EXPEDITION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the sum of six hundred dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to pay the members of the first regiment Minnesota National Guard, for military service performed in the "Brainerd expedition," in pursuance of section two special orders No. eighty, from the commander-in-chief, dated St. Paul, July twenty-fourth, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two.

SEC. 2. That the adjutant general shall require, as evidence of such service, duly certified muster and pay rolls, embracing the name, rank and service performed of each claimant, and upon such proof shall draw his order upon the state auditor, who, upon the approval of the governor, shall issue his warrant upon the state treasurer for the payment of such claims.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXLII.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO REIMBURSE THE COUNTY OF TODD FOR EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE CARE OF A NON-RESIDENT SICK PERSON.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :
