that the state auditor draw his warrant on the state treasurer in favor of Mrs. M. R. Smith for said amount.

CHAPTER CXLIX.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO INDEMNIFY JOHN PETTIJOHN FOR LOSSES SUFFERED BY HIM DURING THE INDIAN OUTBREAK OF 1862.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of six hundred dollars be, John Pettijohn—and the same hereby is, appropriated out of any moneys losses from Indiana. in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to in demnify John Pettijohn for damages for losses suffered by him during and in consequence of the Indian massacre, by the Sioux Indians, in this state, in the fall of 1862.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PAY THE CLAIMS OF CHARLES WIEDEWITSCH AND JULIUS EMMIE.
