CHAPTER CXLIX.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO INDEMNIFY JOHN PETTIJOHN FOR LOSSES SUFFERED BY HIM DURING THE INDIAN OUTBREAK OF 1862.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of six hundred dollars be, and the same hereby is, appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to indemnify John Pettijohn for damages for losses suffered by him during and in consequence of the Indian massacre, by the Sioux Indians, in this state, in the fall of 1862. John Pettijohn—
losses from Indi-
ans.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CL.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PAY THE CLAIMS OF CHARLES WIEDEWITSCH AND JULIUS EMMIE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, viz: *First, To*

Charles Wiedewitsch and Julius Emmie, loss of right arm each.

Charles Wiedewitsch, the sum of one thousand dollars, for the loss of his right arm, caused by a wound received from an Indian in August, A. D. eighteen hundred and sixty-three. *Second*, To Julius Emmie, the sum of one thousand dollars for the loss of his right arm, caused by a wound received from an Indian, in August, eighteen hundred and sixty-three.

Act takes effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CLI.

AN ACT FOR THE RELIEF OF JOHN L. THORN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

John L. Thorn—
construction of a
state road.

SECTION 1. That the sum of one thousand and forty-four dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse and pay John L. Thorn for money paid out and expended by him for the construction of a state road.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
