CHAPTER XXIII.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE (1) OF CHAPTER SEVENTY-EIGHT (78) OF GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO, RELATING TO THE PROTECTION OF FISH IN THE WATERS OF HENNEPIN, RAMSEY AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter seventy-eight (78) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two, be amended so as to read as follows :

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to catch, kill or destroy any fish known by the name of pickerel, or any fish known by the name of bass, from any lake, pond or marsh, or from any inlet or outlet thereof, situated and being within the boundaries of the counties of Hennepin, Ramsey and Washington, state of Minnesota, between the fifteenth day of March, and the fifteenth day of May in any year. Fish not to be taken during spawning season.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
