

CHAPTER XXXI.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TEN, OF CHAPTER NINETEEN OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE, AS AMENDED BY SECTION ONE, OF CHAPTER TEN, OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE, RELATING TO SOLDIERS' ORPHANS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section ten, of chapter nineteen, of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, as amended by section one, of chapter ten, of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one, be further amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 10. The said board of trustees are authorized to place in any soldiers' orphans' home in this state the soldiers' orphans entitled to the benefits of this act, at a cost to the state not to exceed four dollars each, per week.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XXXII.

AN ACT PERTAINING TO THE DUTIES OF THOSE HAVING CHARGE OF OUR STATE INSTITUTIONS.
