Provided, That upon an appeal upon questions of law alone, the justice before whom the action is tried shall upon the request of either party to the suit, return to the district court a true transcript of all the evidence given upon the trial, and the same shall be filed with the clerk of the district court as a part of the return of said justice.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXVII.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A SEVERAL JUDGMENT TO BE TAKEN, ON FAILURE TO PROVE A JOINT CAUSE OF ACTION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Whenever two or more persons are sued as joint defendants, and on the trial the plaintiff fails to prove a joint cause of action against all, but proves a cause of action against one or more of the defendants, judgment may be rendered against him or them, against whom the cause of action is proved.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXVIII.

AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROOF OF CITY ORDINANCES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Whenever the by-laws, ordinances, rules and regulations of any city of this state, incorporated under the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy, entitled "an act to authorize the incorporation of cities," or by any special act prior to or subsequent to that date, have been or shall hereafter be printed and published by authority of the corporation, the same shall be received in evidence in all courts and places without further proof.

City ordinances published by authority, are evidence.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXIX.

AN ACT TO REPEAL A PART OF CHAPTER SEVENTY-ONE OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO, RELATING TO THE EXEMPTION OF WAGES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the proviso contained in section one and embraced in the last three lines of said section one of chapter seventy-one of the general laws of the year A. D. eighteen hundred and seventy-two, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Proviso repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
