CHAPTER LXXI.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE OF CHAPTER THIRTY-FIVE OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF THE YEAR ONE THOU-SAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO, ENTITLED AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE SEVERAL DISTRICT COURTS OF THIS STATE TO CHANGE THE NAME OF PERSON OR PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one of chapter thirty-five of the general laws of the year one thousand eight hundred of seventy-two be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. The several district courts of this state shall hereafter have the exclusive right to change the name of any person, and to make such person the heir-at law of any person whose heir-at-law such applicant applied to be made, when applied to for those or either of those purposes, as hereinafter provided.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXII.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FOUR OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND SEVEN OF THE GENERAL STATUTES RELATING TO GRAND JURIES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Who are exempt from service as grand jurors SECTION 1. The following persons are exempt from service as grand jurors: All United States officers, all judges of courts of record, commissioners of public buildings, auditors and treasurer of state, state librarian, clerks

Exclusive right to change persons name.
