

CHAPTER XC.

AN ACT TO DETACH THE COUNTY OF TODD FROM THE COUNTY OF MORRISON FOR JUDICIAL PURPOSES, AND TO PROVIDE FOR GENERAL TERMS OF THE DISTRICT COURT THEREIN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the county of Todd is hereby detached from the county of Morrison for judicial purposes. Todd county detached from Morrison.

SEC. 2. General terms of the district court shall be held in and for said county of Todd in the seventh judicial district annually, on the third Tuesday of December. Term of court fixed in Todd county.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XCI.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ORGANIZATION OF THE COUNTY OF GRANT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the county of Grant in this state be and the same is hereby declared to be an organized county, with all the rights, privileges and immunities of other organized counties within this state, and the county seat shall be located by the county commissioners hereafter to be elected as provided in this act. Grant county declared organized.

SEC. 2. On the day of the next annual town meeting after the passage of this act, the legal voters of said county may meet at the several places where the last annual election was held in said county, and after choosing judges of election shall, between the hours of nine o'clock in the forenoon and five o'clock in the afternoon, proceed to vote Election of county commissioners
