

CHAPTER XCVII.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ORGANIZATION OF THE COUNTY OF WADENA, IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, AND TO LOCATE ITS COUNTY SEAT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the county of Wadena, in this state, be and the same is hereby declared to be an organized county, with all the rights, privileges and immunities of other counties within this state. Wadena county declared organized.

SEC. 2. The governor of this state shall, within ten days after the passage of this act, appoint three qualified electors of said county of Wadena as commissioners of said county, and the said commissioners shall as soon as may be after their appointment meet at the house of C. B. Jordan and qualify and enter upon the duties of their offices, and they shall hold their offices until the next general election and until their successors are elected and qualified. Governor to appoint county commissioners.

SEC. 3. The county commissioners appointed and qualified according to the provisions of section two of this act, shall at their first meeting, or at any meeting thereafter, appoint qualified persons to fill all the county offices in said county, except clerk of the district court, who shall be appointed by the judge of said court, which persons so appointed and having qualified shall hold their offices until the next general election, and until their successors are elected and qualified. Commissioners to appoint other officers.

SEC. 4. That the town of Wadena, situated on sections six and seven, township one hundred and thirty four, range thirty-five, is hereby designated as the county seat of said county of Wadena. County seat.

SEC. 5. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
