CHAPTER CI.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RICE CITY, MEEKER COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of the township of Rice City, Meeker county, be and the same is hereby changed to that of Darwin.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CII.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON LAKE, IN SHERBURNE COUNTY, TO THAT OF "PALMER."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the name of the township of Clinton Lake, in Sherburne county, being township number thirty-five north, of range number twenty-nine west of the fourth principal meridian, be and the same is hereby changed to and will hereafter be known as the township of "Palmer."

SEC. 2. The officers of said township of Clinton Lake, and all records and proceedings thereof, shall continue to be the officers and records and proceedings of the said township of "Palmer," in the same manner as if the aforesaid change of name had not been made.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.
