CHAPTER CXII.

AN ACT APPROPRIATING MONEYS FOR THE LEGISLATIVE EXPENSES OF THE PRESENT SESSION OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the sum of sixty-five thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be appropriated for the payment of salary, mileage and other expenses of the members and officers of the legislature during the present session. Appropriation for legislative expenses.

CHAPTER CXIII.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE GENERAL EXPENSES OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT FOR THE YEAR EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury belonging to the general revenue fund not otherwise appropriated for the general expenses of the state government for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-four, viz. :

1st.—For executive contingent fund for state purposes
