### CHAPTER CXXXIII.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO INDEMNIFY THE COUNTY OF BECKER, FOR EXPENSES INCURRED IN APPREHENDING AND TRYING KA-KA-BE-SHA, PAWNESS KAH-HE-MAH-BE AND O-KE-MAH, INDIANS OF THE CHIPPEWA NATION.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

To pay expenses of apprehending prisoners. SECTION 1. That the sum of one thousand three hundred and seventy-seven 29-100 dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to indemnify the county of Becker for expenses incurred in apprehending and trying Ka-ka-be-sha, Pawness, Kah-he-muh and O-ke-mak, Indians of the Chippewa nation charged with murdering the Cook family in said family.

To settle claims arising from trial of prisoners. SEC. 2. The sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be expended under the direction of the governor of this state in the settlement of other claims against the state arising by the trial of the murderers of the Cook and Swede families.

When act to take effect. SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and shall be in force from and after its passage.
