

## CHAPTER CXXXIV.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO CAPTAIN MARK HENDRICKS FOR SERVICES DURING THE INDIAN WAR.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. The following sum of money be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated:

1st.—To Mark Hendricks for services rendered in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-two as captain of artillery in the Indian war, including the “battle of Wood Lake,” the sum of two hundred and fifty-eight (258) dollars.

For services rendered during the Indian outbreak of 1862.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.

## CHAPTER CXXXV.

AN ACT FOR THE RELIEF OF PETER HARFF AND APPROPRIATE MONEY TO INDEMNIFY HIM FOR SUPPLIES FURNISHED CAPT. N. W. DICKENSON, CO. “H” SECOND MINNESOTA INFANTRY VOLUNTEERS.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the sum of fifty-four dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the general fund in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated to indemnify Peter Harff for supplies and provisions furnished by him to Capt. N. W. Dickenson’s company “H” 2d Minnesota infantry volunteers, whilst enroute from Mankato to Ft. Snelling to be mustered into the service of the United States.

For military supplies.
