CHAPTER CXXXIV.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO CAPTAIN MARK HEN-DRICKS FOR SERVICES DURING THE INDIAN WAR.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The following sum of money be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the

treasury not otherwise appropriated:

1st.—To Mark Hendricks for services rendered in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-two as captain of artil-dered during the lery in the Indian war, including the " battle of Wood of 1862. Lake," the sum of two hundred and fitty-eight (258) dol-

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force when act to take from and after its passage.

N. W. Dickenson's company "H" 2d Minnesota infantry volunteers, whilst enroute from Mankato to Ft. Snelling to be mustered into the service of the United States.
