

CHAPTER CXXXIX.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO REIMBURSE AND PAY
A. P. NELSON FOR MAINTAINING AND SUPPORTING
ELIAS PETERSON AN INSANE PERSON.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

For support of
insane person.

SECTION 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay and compensate A. P. Nelson for keeping, boarding, clothing and caring for Elias Peterson, an insane person, from the year eighteen hundred and fifty-eight until the present time.

How drawn.

SEC. 2. The auditor of this state shall, upon application of the said A. P. Nelson, draw his warrant for the above amount of money in favor of the said A. P. Nelson, and the same, upon due presentation, shall be paid by the treasurer of this state.

When not to take
effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE SUPPORT AND
MAINTENANCE OF CHRISTIAN SWANSON, WHO LOST
HIS ARMS AND LEGS DURING THE GREAT SNOW STORM
JANUARY SEVENTH, EIGHTH AND NINTH, EIGHTEEN
HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of two hundred dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treas-
