

CHAPTER XLVII.

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION NINETEEN AND TWENTY-ONE OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED OF THE GENERAL STATUTES RELATING TO SABBATH KEEPING OR SABBATH BREAKING.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. Section nineteen of chapter one hundred general statutes, is hereby amended by adding the following words :

Relating to sabbath keeping.

Provided, This section shall not apply to any person who religiously observes the seventh day of the week, commonly called Saturday, as the Sabbath, so far as relates to his work or business avocations.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XLVIII.

AN ACT TO PUNISH GAMBLERS UPON CARS AND STEAMBOATS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Prohibits gambling, penalty for violation.

SECTION 1. Every violation of any statute of this state prohibiting gambling, is hereby declared to be, and made a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by fine not exceeding one hundred dollars and not less than ten dollars, or by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding three months and not less than six days, or both, in the discretion of the court.

Duty of conductors of railroad trains.

SEC. 2. It shall be lawful for any conductor of any railroad train running in this state, to eject from any car
