

## CHAPTER LXXII.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FOUR OF TITLE ONE OF CHAPTER SIXTY-FOUR OF THE GENERAL STATUTES.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That section four of title one of chapter sixty-four of the general statutes be amended by adding thereto the following: *Provided, however,* That such interest shall not disqualify such judge from ordering a change of venue in any such cause, but it shall be the duty of such judge on the application of any party desiring a change of venue in such action to order the same upon a proper showing of such interest on the part of the judge as in other cases of change of venue.

Change of venue

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER LXXIII.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SIXTY-THREE OF CHAPTER TEN OF THE GENERAL STATUTES, RELATING TO THE DUTIES OF TOWN CLERKS.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That section sixty-three of chapter ten of the general statutes be amended so as to read as follows :

Sec. 63. The town clerk shall have the custody of the record books and papers of the town, when no other provision is made by law, and he shall duly file and safely keep all certificates of oaths and other papers required by law to be filed in his office. He may at his discretion appoint a deputy town clerk, for whose acts he shall be

Town clerk to be custodian of books and papers of town, and may appoint deputy.
