

responsible. Before any deputy town clerk shall enter upon the duties of his office, he shall take and subscribe the oath required by law, which oath shall be filed in the office of the clerk of the court.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXIV.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION NINETY-FOUR OF TITLE THREE OF CHAPTER EIGHT OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX, RELATING TO COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section ninety-four of title three of chapter eight of the general statutes of eighteen hundred and sixty-six, be amended so as to read as follows :

Meetings of county commissioners, when.

“Section 94. The board of county commissioners shall meet at the county seat of their respective counties for the purpose of transacting such business as may devolve upon or be brought before them on the first Tuesday of January and on the fourth Monday of July, in each year, and may hold such extra sessions as they deem necessary for the interest of the county. Such extra sessions shall be called by a majority of the board, and the clerk shall give at least ten days' notice thereof to the commissioners, but no regular session shall continue longer than six days, and no extra session longer than three days.”

Relating to change of time for sessions.

SEC. 2. Every thing or act required of said board of county commissioners, or which they were authorized to do, at their September session, as heretofore authorized, shall be done hereafter at their July sessions, provided for in the foregoing section.
