CHAPTER LXXV.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section seven of chapter twenty-six of the general laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-ore, be so amended as to read as follows: "All actions commenced before a justice Patent rights-actions to recov-of the peace, in the district court, or in a court of com- re relating theremon pleas, in this state, to recover any debt, demand or sum of money, upon any promissory note or other written instrument where the consideration thereof was for a patent right, or any interest therein, shall be brought in the county where the defendant resides, if a resident of this state, at the time of the commencement of such action and not elsewhere."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from when act to take and after its passage. effect.
