SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXII.

AN ACT TO ATTACH CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF LE SUEUR IN THE COUNTY OF LE SUEUR.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the west half of the northwest quarter of section twelve in town one hundred and eleven north, of range twenty-five west, is hereby detached from school district number four in LeSueur county and attached to and made a part of the independent school district of the town of LeSueur in said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER CXIII.

AN ACT TO AMEND "AN ACT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND BETTER REGULATION OF THE COMMON SCHOOLS IN THE VILLAGE OF NORTHFIELD, THE SAME BEING DESIGNATED AS DISTRICT NO. THREE, IN RICE COUNTY, APPROVED MARCH THIRD, EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FOUR."
