

CHAPTER CXVIII.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE ACTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE COUNTY OF SHERBURNE, STATE OF MINNESOTA, UPON THE SIXTH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, A. D. EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO; SETTING APART THE CONGRESSIONAL TOWNSHIP OF HAVEN FROM THE TOWN OF CLINTON LAKE, NOW CALLED PALMER.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the action heretofore taken by the board of county commissioners for the county of Sherburne, state of Minnesota, setting apart the congressional township of Haven from the town of Clinton Lake, now called Palmer, is hereby legalized and made valid.

SEC. 2. This act to take effect and be enforced from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXIX.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE PLAT OF THE VILLAGE OF ALDEN, AND CONVEYANCES MADE IN REFERENCE THERETO, APPROVED MARCH TENTH. EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one of said act be amended [so as to read] as follows:

Section 1. The original proprietors of the village of Alden in the county of Freeborn and state of Minnesota, or their executors, administrators or assigns may file or cause to be filed in the register of deeds office in said county a certificate under their hand clearly designating the location of said village plat with reference to the
