tricted into three commissioner districts, as follows: That town-ship number one hundred and nine in range forty, forty one, forty-two and forty three, and township number one hundred and ten in range forty and forty one constitute commissioner district number one. That township number one hundred and ten, range forty-two and forty three and township number one hundred and eleven in range forty, forty-one, forty-two and forty-three constitute district number two, and that township number one hundred and twelve and one hundred and thirteen in range forty, forty-one, forty-two and forty-three constitute commissioner district number three.

SEC. 2. That the county commissioners now elected shall hold their office in their respective districts during the term for which

they were elected.

SEC. 3. This act shall be in force on and after its passage. Approved March 5, 1874.

## CHAPTER CL.

AN ACT RELATING TO THE EXECUTION OF DEEDS BY THE LAKEWOOD CEMETERY ASSOCIATION OF HENNEPIN COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The Lakewood cemetery association of Hennepin county may and hereby is authorized to execute deeds as provided for in section one hundred and two of title five of chapter thirty-four of the general statutes of eighteen hundred and sixty-six, and and also to execute deeds signed by the secretary and treasurer of said cemetery association.

SEC. 2. All deeds heretofore executed by said Lakewood cemetery association signed by the secretary and treasurer thereof are hereby declared to be valid and of the same force and effect as if they had been signed by the president and treasurer of said ceme-

tery association.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
