tor he shall upon demand of the county treasurer for money belonging to said funds for the cost of said bridge as reported by said committee, in case the same does not exceed the sum of one thousand dollars, and the state treasurer shall pay over said moneys to the county treasurer of said Carlton county upon said order, and said moneys shall be distributed by said county treasurer upon the order of said board of county commissioners, in payment of the cost of said bridge.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER CLXXI.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO BUILD A BRIDGE ACROSS THE SOUTH BRANCH OF CROW RIVER, IN MEEKER COUNTY.

. Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars or as much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund or out of the first moneys which shall come into the treasury belonging to said fund not already appropriated, to build a substantial bridge across the south branch of Crow river in Meeker county, and said bridge when completed shall be kept in repair by said country [county,] and be forever free from toll.

SEC. 2. Said bridge shall be built under the direction of the board of county commissioners of the county of Meeker, and no part of said appropriation shall be paid out of the state treasury

until said bridge is completed and ready for travel.

SEC. 3. That the governor shall appoint three persons, citizens of Meeker county, as a committee on the part of the state to view said bridge when completed, and examine contracts, vouchers and accounts respecting its construction and the cost thereof, and make a report of such cost to the state auditor.

SEC. 4. That upon the receipt of said report by the state auditor he shall draw his order in favor of said county of Meeker on the state treasurer for any money belonging to the internal improve-

ment fund for the cost of said bridge, not to exceed five hundred dollars. The state treasurer shall pay over such money to the county treasurer of Meeker county upon said order or orders, and such money shall be paid out by the county treasurer upon the order of the board of county commissioners in payment of the cost of said bridge.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER CLXXII.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE, OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY IN AID OF BUILDING A ROAD TO PIGEON RIVER, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section one of chapter one hundred and twenty-three of the special laws of eighteen hundred and seventy three, be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words "that the provisions of said chapter forty of the general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, have been complied with, and inserting in place thereof the words "that the provisions of sections one, two, three and four of chapter forty of the general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, have been complied with."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.
