

the terms of said court as the same are fixed by this act, and all continuances, appeals, motions, notices or other proceedings taken or made to or for any term of said court shall be considered and construed to be made or taken to the terms of said court as fixed by this act, and no term of said court shall be held prior to the second Monday of May, eighteen hundred and seventy-five.

SEC. 3. Chapter ninety-eight of the general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed. Repeal of inconsistent acts.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

CHAPTER LXXVIII.

AN ACT TO PRESCRIBE THE TIMES OF HOLDING GENERAL TERMS OF THE DISTRICT COURT IN THE COUNTIES OF CARLTON, BECKER AND ST. LOUIS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the general terms of the district court in and for the eleventh judicial district shall be held in the counties of Carlton, Becker and St. Louis at the times hereinafter prescribed, to-wit: Fixing terms of court in the counties of Carlton, Becker and St. Louis.

In the county of Carlton on the first Tuesday of October in each year.

In the county of Becker on the second Tuesday of October in each year.

In the county of Saint Louis on the third Tuesday of May and on the fourth Tuesday of November in each year.

SEC. 2. All writs, recognizances and all other papers and proceedings made returnable to the district court of the said several counties shall be considered and deemed to be returnable to the terms of said courts as the same are fixed by this act, and all continuances, appeals, motions, notices or other proceedings taken or made to or for any term of said court shall be considered and construed to be made or taken to the terms of said court as fixed by this act. All proceedings returnable to said terms.

SEC. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed. Repeal of inconsistent acts.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
